INDONESIAN INDEPENDENCE DAY

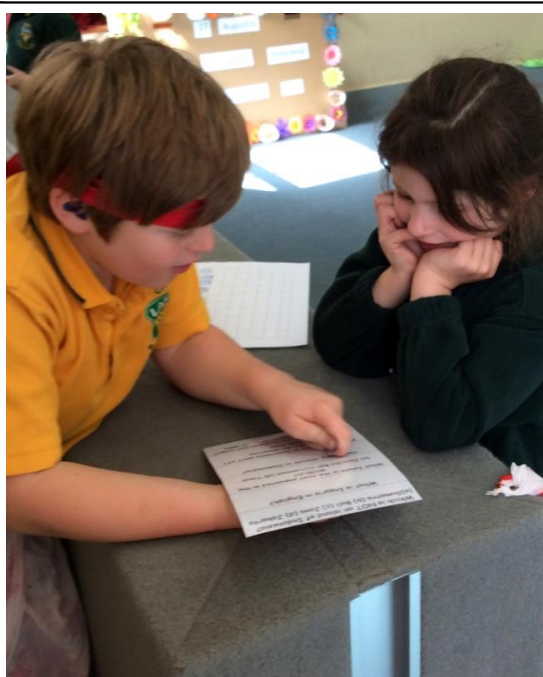
